**PUBLIC HEARING

**Public Hearing:** The purpose of the Public Hearing was to receive public comment on proposed revisions to the *Greene County Zoning Ordinance*. The proposed amendments primarily relate to the establishment of appropriate restrictions on and regulation of poultry production in Greene County, Georgia. An amendment to allow self-storage facilities as a Conditional Use in the “B1 Neighborhood Convenience Commercial District” is also proposed.

A number of interested citizens and individuals addressed the Board to provide public comment including John Dyar, Linda Johnson, Marie Bruno, Dick Schmidt, Woody Hanson, Marie Bruno, Andy Dyar, Zeb Duvall, and another unidentified citizen. The Board members listened intently to the public input for purposes of evaluating the perspectives shared by the speakers and how such input may impact the proposed amendments to the Zoning Code.
